BY-LAW 980-96

A BY-LAW OF THE COUNTY OF THORHILD NO. 7 TO PREVENT THE DUMPING OF ANY ASHES, GARBAGE, REFUSE, DIRT, STONES, FILTH, RUBBISH, OR MANURE OFF ANY ROAD, ROAD ALLOWANCE, STREET OR LANE, PARK, PUBLIC PLACE OR WATER COURSE WITHIN THE COUNTY OF THORHILD NO. 7

WHEREAS

Section 7 (a), (c), (i) (ii) of the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, 1994, cM-26.1, provides that Council of the County of Thorhild No. 7 may establish a bylaw for respecting the safety, health and welfare of people and nuisances including unsightly property.

NOW THEREFORE

The Council of the County of Thorhild No. 7, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The purpose of this Bylaw is to prevent littering within the Municipal boundaries.

2. Definitions:

The following words and phrases mean:

2.1 "debris" means ashes, garbage, refuse, dirt, stones, filth, rubbish or manure.

2.2 "Property" means road, road allowance, street, lane, park, public place, and water course within the County of Thorhild No. 7.

2.3 "designated party" means Councillor, Bylaw Officer, Health Authority, Sanitary Inspector and Municipal Council.

3. That no person shall personally, nor by his servant or agent, throw, place, deposit or leave any debris upon any public property, other than designated areas, within the Municipality of the County of Thorhild No.7.
4. Any person throwing, placing, depositing or leaving any debris on any public property shall, within twenty-four hours after having been notified by the designated party, remove the said debris and place it at the nearest Municipal nuisance grounds or other place designated in such notice. In default, the Council may order removal and charge expenses to the party in default, and the County may recover costs by Court action of competent jurisdiction.
5. No person shall be relieved of liability under paragraph three of this Bylaw by reason of having been convicted under paragraph two; nor shall any person be relieved from liability under paragraph two by compliance with the terms of paragraph three.
6. Penalties for infraction of this Bylaw shall not exceed \$2000.00 and are exclusive of costs or imprisonment for any period not exceeding six months in case of non-payment of the fine and costs imposed for any such infraction.

Bylaw 824-83 is hereby repealed.

This Bylaw comes into effect on the day of final reading.
