

COUNTY OF THORHILD NO. 7
BYLAW 1150-2011

A BYLAW OF THE COUNTY OF THORHILD NO. 7, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING THE ADMINISTRATIVE FUNCTION AND SET FEES IN RELATION TO *THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION AND PROTECTION OF PRIVACY ACT*

WHEREAS

Pursuant to Section 95 of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. F-25, as amended from time to time, the County of Thorhild No. 7 must designate a person or group of persons as the head of the municipality for the purposes of the *Act*; and

AND WHEREAS

Pursuant to Sections 93 and 95 of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. F-25, as amended from time to time, the County of Thorhild No. 7 may set fees payable to the municipality for services under the *Act* and Regulations;

**NOW
THEREFORE**

The Council for the County of Thorhild No. 7 in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This bylaw shall be referred to as the "FOIP Bylaw" for the County of Thorhild No. 7.

2. DEFINITIONS

In this bylaw, the following definitions of items and terms shall be:

- 2.1 "**Act**" means the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. F-25, as amended from time to time;
- 2.2 "**Applicant**" means a person who makes a request for access to a record under Section 7(1) of the *Act*;
- 2.3 "**Chief Administrative Officer**" means the person appointed as the Chief Administrative Officer of the County of Thorhild No. 7 and includes any person who holds the position of Chief Administrative Officer in an acting capacity;
- 2.4 "**County**" means the County of Thorhild No. 7, including any board, committee, commission, panel, agency or corporation that is created or owned by the County, but does not include the Thorhild Regional Water Services Commission, the Thorhild Regional Waste Management Services Commission, and the County of Thorhild Regional Library Board.
- 2.5 "**Province**" means the Province of Alberta;

**3. DESIGNATED
HEAD**

- 3.1 For the purpose of the *Act*, the Chief Administrative Officer is designated as the Head of the County.

4. FEES

- 4.1 Where an applicant is required to pay a fee for services, the fee payable is in accordance with the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Regulation*, Alta. Reg. 186/2008, as amended from time to time, or a successor Regulation that sets fees for requests for information from the Province.

**5. EFFECTIVE
DATE**

5.1 This Bylaw shall take effect and come into force effective after final reading and signature thereof by the Chief Elected Official and Chief Administrative Officer, or their authorized delegates.

5.2 Where a request for information is received, but has not been disposed of before the effective date of this Bylaw, the request is deemed to be a request made on the date that this Bylaw takes effect and comes into force, under the provision of this Act, for the purposes of the fees payable under this Bylaw.

**6. CONSEQUENTIAL
AMENDMENTS**

6.1 Bylaw 1002/99 is hereby amended by deleting the third Preamble to Bylaw 1002/99 referring to the Act and the portion of Schedule A of Bylaw 1002/99 entitled "Formal Requests".

6.2 Bylaw 5-99 of the Village of Thorhild is hereby repealed.

This Bylaw comes into effect on the day of final reading.


READ A FIRST TIME IN COUNCIL THIS *fourteenth* DAY OF *June*, 2011.
