

### *HOT TUB INSTALLATION*

If you are planning to install a hot tub, there are land use and building regulations that you will need to follow.

Any structure that contains more than 600 millimetres or 24 inches of water is categorized as a swimming pool under the Alberta Building Code. Building and electrical permits are required.

Fences with locking gates will be required if your hot tub does not have a locking cover which has the strength to support an adult and is complete with a lockable device that prevents access to the water. In effect, the cover must remain in place and be locked at all times when the hot tub is not in use.

Hot tubs are the responsibility of the property owner and must comply with the County of Thorhild's Land Use Bylaw and the Alberta Building Code.
